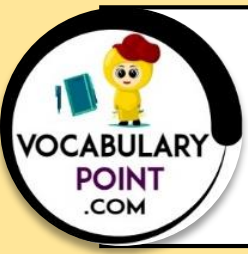




# Conjunction and its Types

## List of conjunctions

<b>and</b>	<b>still</b>	<b>Either-or</b>	<b>Not only</b>
<b>Until</b>	<b>however</b>	<b>So-as</b>	<b>than</b>
<b>if</b>	<b>whereas</b>	<b>Both-and</b>	<b>Whether-or</b>
<b>till</b>	<b>only</b>	<b>Such-as</b>	<b>No soon</b>



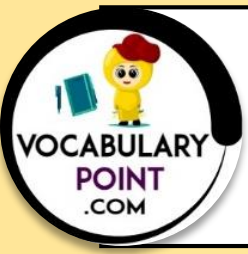
# Conjunction and its Types

## Cumulative conjunction

Cumulative conjunction is used to add one sentence with another.

## Examples

- 1) Tariq stood first in the class and his father gave him a pizza.
- 2) They toil not, neither do they spin.
- 3) She must weep, or she will die.



# Conjunction and its Types

## Adverse conjunction

It is used to show adverse relationship between two sentences.

### Examples:

Arena is hardworking but she is greedy also.

## Correlative conjunction

As the name indicates, it is the conjunction which is used in pairs.

### Examples:

Tipu sultan was not only a king but also a great soldier.

## Compound conjunction

Some compounds are used as conjunctions like:

He gets up early in the morning so that he may reach the school in time.
