ACTIVE & PASSIVE VOICE

PRESENT INDEFINITE EXAMPLES

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Active Voice: People buy fresh fruits from the market.

Passive Voice: Fresh fruits are bought from the market by people.

Active Voice: The chef prepares delicious meals in the kitchen.

Passive Voice: Delicious meals are prepared in the kitchen by the chef.

Active Voice: Children play with toys in the park.

Passive Voice: Toys are played with by children in the park.

Active Voice: The company sells high-quality products.

Passive Voice: High-quality products are sold by the company.

Active Voice: The teacher explains the lesson to the students.

Passive Voice: The lesson is explained to the students by the teacher.

Active Voice: The delivery man delivers packages to the customers.

Passive Voice: Packages are delivered to the customers by the delivery man.

ACTIVE & PASSIVE VOICE

PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSES EXAMPLES

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Active Voice: The workers are building a new bridge.

Passive Voice: A new bridge is being built by the workers.

Active Voice: The dog is barking at the mailman.

Passive Voice: The mailman is being barked at by the dog.

Active Voice: The singer is performing on stage.

Passive Voice: The performer is being watched by the audience on stage.

Active Voice: The children are playing in the playground.

Passive Voice: The playground is being used by the children to play.

Active Voice: The chef is cooking dinner.

Passive Voice: Dinner is being cooked by the chef.

Active Voice: The company is launching a new product.

Passive Voice: A new product is being launched by the company.

PAST TENSE EXAMPLES
